EVERY DAY

CHILDREN NEED TO BRING:

- **Nutritious lunch, snacks, and drink bottle (Water is best)**
- **Something to be worn on the feet for walking to the pools as often there are prickles e.g. jandels**
- **Change of clothes**
- **Named sun hat**
- **Named swimsuit, rashshirt and towel**

To be sun safe your child must have their own rash shirt to swim. We are unable to provide swimsuits and rashshirts for children this year due to COVID

Remember to sign your child in and sign them out at the end of the day

If your child is walking home unaccompanied, please ensure the unaccompanied form is completed.

Beach Trip

Date: Friday 14th January

Time: 9.00am – 3.00pm

You need to bring these essential items:

- Large Lunch and snacks
- Large Drink bottle - water is best
- Change of clothes
- Named sun hat
- Named swimsuit, rash shirt and towel
- A fun happy attitude



Your child is welcome to bring their own sand toys on the day please ensure they are named.

Arrive at the Katikati Community Centre by 9.00am.

Students sign in and an identification wristband will be given (these must be kept on during the entire trip)

The bus drops the students at the reserve where the children will have morning tea then will do a short walk along the beach.

The children will be given a safety talk before being allowed to swim.

Staff will be in the water with children as well as on the waters edge with children not wanting to swim.

The children can then play in the playground or play on the beach

Everyone will board the bus and travel back to the Katikati Community Centre for 3.00pm pickup

Bush Reserve and Playground

Date: Wednesday 19th January

Time: 9.00am – 3.00pm

You need to bring these essential items:

- Large Lunch and snacks
- Large Drink bottle - water is best
- Change of clothes
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Named sun hat
- A fun happy attitude



Arrive at the Katikati Community Centre by 9.00am.

Students sign in and an identification wristband will be given (these must be kept on during the entire trip)

The bus drops the students at the reserve where the children will have morning tea then the students will be given a safety talk before completing the bush walk.

Depart the reserve at approximately 12noon to the playground where we will have lunch and then it will be free play for the children.

Everyone will board the bus and travel back to the Katikati Community Centre for 3.00pm pickup

Marshalls Animal Park Trip

Date: Thursday 27th January

Time: 9.00am – 3.00pm

You need to bring these essential items:

- Large Lunch and snacks
- Large Drink bottle - water is best
- Change of clothes
- Named sun hat
- A fun happy attitude



Arrive at the Katikati Community Centre by 9.00am.

Students sign in and an identification wristband will be given (these must be kept on during the entire trip)

The bus drops the students at Marshalls Animal Park where the children will have morning tea and a safety talk.

The children will then go around the animals in the park in groups and will be given 1 packet of animal food.

The children will have lunch and have free play in the animal park playground.

Children will enjoy a short walk to the waterfall before boarding the bus and travelling back to the Katikati Community Centre for 3.00pm pickup
